INITIAL QUESTIONS

- Did you read our author instructions and submission guidelines, available as PDF downloads on www.JEAMS.org?
- Was your manuscript already published elsewhere? e.g. self published on blog or repository like arXiv, student journal, etc.?
- Do you (your lab, your faculty advisor / PI) have the legal authority to transfer the copyright of the manuscript to any journal?
- Are all of your co-authors truly authors, and do they each know already that they are being listed as authors?

INITIAL SUBMISSION

- PDF version of main paper
- PDF version of Figures (each exhibit must get its own separate page) Supplemental Information
- PDF version of Supplemental Information

IF PROCEEDING TO PEER REVIEW

- PDF of every cited Reference, with the filenames numbered in order of the citations
- Signed Copyright Transfer Agreement (CTA), provided confidentially by JEAMS to the corresponding author
- Signed Author Contributions form
- Signed Conflicts of Interest disclosure form

IF PROCEEDING TO STATISTICAL REVIEW AND EDITING

- Original raw data as Excel file, entire unedited gels / blots, etc.
- Uploaded data sets, for example according to: <http://www.nature.com/authors/policies/availability.html>
- High resolution versions of figures
- Completed Statistical Analysis section in the Supplemental Information
- One color headshot photo of either the primary author or corresponding author (preferably with current Ivy League affiliation)
- One sentence summary of the manuscript / investigation
